ABSTRACTS FOR peer review

Submission deadline: March 12th, 2025

(ORAL presentations)

- Must be submitted in English;
- Must have a maximum of 300 words;
- Must have between 3 and 5 keywords;
- Authors are responsible for the content of their presentations;
- Authors should indicate their preferred type of presentation – Oral or Poster. However, this cannot be guaranteed and will be communicated on acceptance.
- Abstract should be submitted by the following link (you may have to create an account if you don't have one):

Special considerations

- **Individual authors may submit a maximum of 2 abstracts as first author.**
- **In case the first author is unable to attend, a registered co-author is permitted to present the research on their behalf.**
- **It is possible to appear as a co-author on other abstracts. However, each author can only present a maximum of 2 abstracts (oral or poster).**
- **Abstracts must be submitted under one of following categories:**
 - Sports Performance/ Psychology
 - Outdoor Education/Motor Learning
 - Health and Wellbeing

- Industry/Adventure Tourism

- If an abstract is accepted, it will only be considered for the conference if at least one author has registered.
- All accepted abstracts will be published in the conference proceedings indexed on SCOPUS.

The Oral presentation should follow a traditional format, with presenters being afforded 7 minutes to present their findings and an additional 3 minutes to answer questions. The time limit for each presentation and related questions and answers will be strictly observed.
